Submission of work (original work only accepted - no photos)

- **4 framed paintings/works and 4 pieces of 3D work** may be submitted (request extra forms if needed)
- Work must not previously have been exhibited at TAS exhibitions (except portfolios)
- Work must be numbered in priority order
- All work must be well framed and strung securely with cord
- Backs of pictures require taping to cover sprigs and sharp edges
- Multiple images to be fixed on a single background and exhibited as one work
- Paintings must be dry
- Please inform the exhibition secretary before the event if your 3D work is large (sue@drums.myzen.co.uk)
- No unsold work can be taken before the end of the exhibition

Portfolio

- **4 unframed works** accepted, labelled on the back
- All require card mounts and backing, plus sealed clear cellophane covering

Submission Fees (cheques payable to TAS)

- £2 each framed work, 3D work etc.
- £3 each NFS - £1 each portfolio

Sales

Payments are made by the next members meeting. Commission is 15%

Labelling

All work, i.e. exhibition work and portfolios require:

Label on the back or stuck to the base in the case of sculpture. Minimum size of 2" x 1", to provide the following information in the order shown:

Artist Name	
Address	
Tel no	
Title	
Medium	
Price	Priority No

Please write clearly. Limit the title to 28 characters including spaces.

Additionally, for exhibition work only, use the enclosed tie-on labels or print-off from the web site:

- Each exhibition piece of work requires one of these labels
- Attach the label by a long string to the cord on the rear of the painting, so that the label will hang over the front, or secure it to the sculpture
- This does not apply to portfolios

Stewarding

- Sessions are 10.30am to 1.30pm and 1.30pm to 4.30pm
- ALL exhibitors are expected to steward. Please check your availability
- If, during the exhibition you are unable to steward, IT IS YOUR responsibility in the first instance to find a replacement
